Use Trustland funds to assist in the funding of a language arts and math teacher to help keep class sizes at an adequate size.

Amendment to Current Plan/Budget

Funds of \$18,032.00 of the budget will be used for the purchase of technology. Amendment was approved and signed off by the council.

School Mission, Vision and Goals for 24-25 School Year

Increase student proficiency in math and language arts classes by 3% for both 6th and 7th grades by the end of the 24-25 school year.

End of level RISE data will be used to measure the effectiveness of our goal.

Counselor Presentation (Brian Armstrong)

Counselor Armstrong explained Lifeskills Link, a new program to help students learn targeted intervention and cognitive-behavioral skill development. The curriculum is built on an evidence-based model of cognitive behavior therapy with a unique self-directed learning approach which helps students overcome self-defeating thoughts and behaviors.
